MINUTES: June 22, 2023

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- B. **Pinon Canyon Maneuver Site (Nieb):** Benjamin and Cynthia have spent a lot of time going back and forth discussing how they're going to receive documents that they've requested because there's been some problems.
